Chairman's Message

2022 was an amazing year for Karwan-e-Hayat.

We faced immense challenges in the Post-Covid era, ranging from increased patient visits to record inflation, higher electricity, fuel and medicine costs and escalating expenses associated with patients care (bed occupancy, meals, utilities, etc.).

The situation was further compounded by lower inflow of donor funds which had been largely diverted to flood relief efforts. I am pleased to report, that despite the headwinds, the Team responded well and remained focused on providing quality patient care.

During the second half of 2022, the OPD Block was expanded through a donor funded project which was executed and commissioned in a safe, timely and professional manner. Another donor funded venture, the Solar Power Project, is in the final commissioning stage. It will assist in lowering our electricity bills in 2023 and beyond.

Looking ahead, the Team aspires to handle even more patients and provide care and rehabilitation to the mentally ill among the underserved segment of our society.


I would like to thank all our donors, advisors, well-wishers, management and the Board for their commitment and participation in supporting Karwan-e-Hayat in the vital role it is playing.


